Do You Know Your Group's Classification?

Below is the the information from the Delegate's Report at Fall Assembly about meeting classifications. Your group can figure out its correct classification. As things unfold, a group's classification will determine where/how they are represented in the Al-Anon service structure. The WSO will create at least one new Area for PEMs because they aren't tied to any geographic location. WA Area is exploring creating a new District for PEMs that want to be tied to Washington and have a voice at Washington Area Assemblies. But that all is still yet to be officially determined.

Clarification of Meeting Terms/Definitions

1. Permanent Electronic Meeting (PEM) = virtual meeting; meets solely and permanently online
2. Hybrid Meeting = face-to-face meeting with Zoom meeting same day & time; both are connected
3. Temporary Virtual = meets electronically due to COVID or other reason with the intention of returning to face-to-face
4. Face-to-face (FTF) Meeting = meets in-person only; no virtual component
5. Concurrent meeting = was same meeting originally; now half-electronic and half-FTF which are not connected

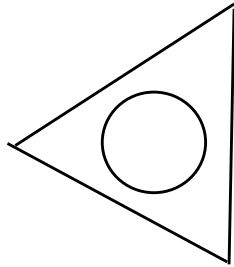

Beware: If you call in to a video conference, your phone number is displayed for all to see.

Be sure you are in a private space so that people who are not in All-Anon don't see or hear the meeting.

If you want to be visible to others you'll need to call in with a smart phone or a computer that has a camera. Or you can choose to not allow video and just use the audio option. Mute yourself when you're not talking - whether you are in a tele-phone or video meeting.
